

Nursery Fees Riverside Nursery Schools St Margarets

Registration Fee (non-refundable) £200
Nursery Deposit £500

Please note, the fees above are not required for children accessing their funded entitlement only. In all other cases, the Deposit is refundable and returned to you when the required notice is given for your child to leave the nursery. Please see our Parent Terms and Conditions for further information.

Available Nursery Sessions:

Our standard sessions run from Monday to Friday, 9:00am to 3:00pm. We offer early starts and late finishes, from 8:00am to 4:00pm respectively. We are open term time for 38 weeks per year. The fees shown below are to be paid termly, and reflect the total yearly fee divided by three, so the price you pay is the same each term regardless of term length.

Late Collection:

£20.00 per every fifteen minutes of lateness after your child's expected collection time. The fee applies at any point in each fifteen minutes of late collection.

Nursery Fees:

All eligible children can access their funded hours at no cost. Our sessions run in three-hour morning or afternoon blocks. Morning sessions run from 9:00am to 12:00pm. Afternoon sessions run from 12:00pm to 3:00pm.

Funded hours are provided at no charge. The 'Funded Fee' columns reflect the cost of additional hours and voluntary extras for each booking pattern. Government funding only covers the cost of the provision of childcare and the delivery of the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS). The funding does not include any of the other services that our nurseries provide, which include, but are not limited to:

- Meals and snacks
- Hygiene consumables
- Enrichment resources above EYFS
- Extracurricular activities

**All charges for the above are voluntary for children accessing funded hours. Parents may opt out of any or all.*

The fees above show the amount you would pay for your child's place if taking a combination of funded hours, voluntary extras, and sessions that are not covered by the Government funding.

These voluntary extras are calculated as follows (included as part of the above fees):

Meals and snacks - £2 per day
 Hygiene consumables - £2 per day
 Enrichment resources above EYFS - £5 per day
 Extracurricular activities - £19 per day

Funded entitlement only places are available. Please speak with the nursery about booking patterns. Extracurricular Activities:

These activities form part of our enrichment programme, running alongside the EYFS curriculum. Participation is optional. Children not taking part will follow our EYFS curriculum during these sessions.

We request that all nursery fees are paid before the start of the month. Payment details and the amounts you will need to pay will be sent to you in an invoice through our parent app, as well as information on late payment charges should we need to apply them.

Tax-Free Childcare is a Government service to help working parents with the cost of their childcare. For every £8 a parent pays into their childcare account, the Government will pay an extra £2, up to a maximum of £2,000 every year for each child.
